Foster Club

Subscribe for an annual fee of \$24.95 and receive unlimited access to foster parent materials and online tests. Once you are finished, print your certificate and submit it with an external training document to receive credit.

Foster Care & Adoptive Community, Inc. (fosterparentstest.com)

Online courses on oodles of subjects, trainings vary in price, most are \$5 - \$10/credit hour. You will receive a certificate after completion, both the certificate and external training documentation need to be submitted for credit.
